

### Introduction

Byways House is located in the town centre of Salisbury, on the top of a hill in a quiet residential area. Our home is a Victorian style house offering 23 guest bedrooms over 3 stories, with 1 room wheel chair accessible. Our home is over 200 years old although having a modern extension to the back of the house; whilst we aim to meet the needs of all our guests there are some features that may make access difficult for people with limited mobility.

We have a free car park and on street parking facilities. We are a 20 minutes walk from the Salisbury train station and just a 2 minute drive by taxi. The bus station is a 5 minutes walk.

### Pre-arrival

We are located just off the ring road on Fowlers Road on a residential road with minimal noise and yet only a 5 minute walk to the centre or a 2 minute drive. Salisbury is best known for its famous Cathedral and its surrounding area such as Stonehenge just 10 miles away. We are a 5 minute walk or a 2 minute drive to the centre where there are lots of restaurants and shops. We have no bus route on Fowlers road however we are a 5 minute walk to the bus station. Our train station is 20 minutes walk away or 2 minute drive. We are very familiar with our local taxi companies and transport can be arranged. We have a cat; however we are a pet friendly home and welcome quiet dogs on the ground floor. Our room brochures and menu can be provided in larger print, but regret we do not have the facility to prepare information in Braille.

### Arrival and car parking

To ensure your accommodation is ready we ask that guests do not normally check in before 2pm with the latest check in at 9pm, unless by prior arrangement.

We have a gravel car park to the side of the house with a narrow entrance. Otherwise you can park on the street. Resident Parking applies, however you can collect a day past ticket free of charge from reception. The car park leads to the entrance with 1 stone step 18cm high and a further 2 steps 6cm and 11cm high to the main door. We offer assistance with luggage.

### Main entrance

There are 5 stone steps 14cm high to the entrance of the house from the street and a further 2 steps 6cm and 11cm high to the main door width of 97cm.

From the car park there is 1 stone step 18cm high to the entrance. Please ring the blue button for the intercom upon arrival and quote your name. We provide you with keys to the front door so you can let yourself in and out at your convenience. We can provide an additional set if required.

### **Public Areas – guest lounge and dining room**

The entrance and main hallway is 8.5 metres long and at times 2 meters wide. With Victorian style tiled floor leading on to a long ground floor carpeted corridor with a slight slope. Access to all public areas is on the same level with no stairs or steps. From the entrances we have a guest lounge with synthetic tiled flooring where daily newspapers, leaflets, maps and a computer are available; with the dining room next door also with synthetic flooring with seating 42 cm high. From the entrance we have the main stair case with 17 steps 18cm high with a curve towards the top at a 90 degree angle. We have 13 guest bedrooms on the ground floor, 1 with wheel chair access and 6 rooms on the first floor and a further 4 on the second floor. There is a public toilet on the ground floor and on the first floor

### **Bedrooms**

We offer 23 guest bedrooms over 3 stories, 20 of which are en-suite. The rooms along the ground floor corridor have a modern touch and the room on the first and second floor are in the old part of the house which has a Victorian style to them. We have one disabled room which has twin beds and has a private bathroom. The room has a concert path 135cm leading to it from the gravel car park, with the outside back door width 90cm. The bathroom has been modified to fit a wheel chair and the bath and toilet lowered. The bath is 43cm from the floor and the toilet 39cm with a support rail to the right. The bath is fitted with a shower and a chair is also available from reception to fit into the bath should one be needed.

### **Garden**

The back garden is private; however guests are welcome to use the front garden, which is accessible from the front door, down 2 steps. There is flower beds, surrounding hedges and trees, there is also a seating area.

### **Additional information**

There are fire extinguishers on all the landings and on the ground floor corridors, with fire doors throughout the house, one being fully automated. All rooms are equipped with smoke detectors and Fire Action Instructions. Fire escape routes are indicated with emergency lighting and signs. In the event of a fire the fire bells will be activated. Please advise us upon check in if you need any assistance to evacuate the building.

Smoking is illegal on the premises and there is a penalty charge should you be found smoking.

We do cater for special dietary requirements; however this must be arranged prior to arrival.

We can keep medication or special dietary foods in our fridge, but there is no access available between 21.00 and 07.30.
